Ministry Overview

Tyler BSM comprises 14 staff on six campuses reaching out to over 25,000 college students in East Texas. Our goal is to reach students in a pivotal time, build a personal foundation of faith, equip them to share their faith with others, and send them to lead in their church, workplace, or as career missionaries. Our focus is evangelism, discipleship, and mission mobilization.

Beach Reach

Tyler BSM took a group of 66 to South Padre Island over spring break. As a team, we served college students through acts of service and sharing the gospel. We were able to see seven people start their relationship with Christ! We are celebrating the transformation in their lives and our students who grew in sharing their faith. The impact of Beach Reach continues as we see students excited to return to share with friends and family.

Missions

Through Go Now Missions this summer, we will have 18 student missionaries serving in Texas, Arizona, New York, Vermont, Utah, Mexico, Brazil, Eastern Europe, England, New Zealand, and Thailand. Next year, CMI's Jesse Murphy and Garret Johnson will serve in Eastern Europe with our Reach the Campus Reach the World partnerships. We hope to see Tyler BSM be a place that sends students and staff to under-resourced locations in Texas and worldwide.

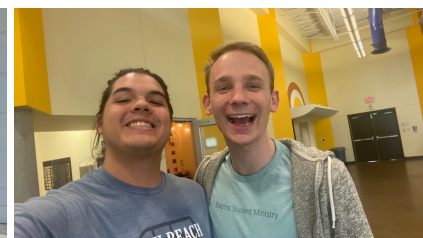

Kilgore - New Life in Christ

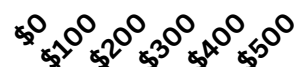
